Lateral Load Performance Of Multi-storey Steel Building With And Without Bracing On Staad Pro

- Performed structural analysis of a multi-storey steel building in STAAD.Pro to evaluate the impact of various bracing configurations under wind and seismic loads.
- Conducted comparative assessments of models with and without bracing to determine their effect on lateral stability and deflection control.
- Found that centrally placed cross bracing provides superior resistance to lateral forces, significantly improving structural stiffness and serviceability.
